New Business

They would like grant so they could seell the milk for \$10 instead of the \$18 actual cost. After much discussion, it was decided that the board needesd more information about this program

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such as why the boutique? Hours of the boutique? How would the integrity of the milk be maintained?

- Elections Allison has served her two terms as president. Her first term began in November of 2015. We will need to decide how to proceed. <u>IAllison n</u> <u>January of 2020, Allison</u> will post <u>on website</u> that <u>we are acceptingthey are</u> <u>taking nominations</u> applications for a president-elect and other board members.
