Kajsa Brimdyr, PhD, CLC Kajsa is an experienced ethnographer who has worked with health care, municipal and technological businesses. She has conducted research in the U.S., Sweden, Latvia, Egypt and Iceland. Her current research involves using video ethnography and interaction analysis to change practice in hospital settings to improve continuous skin-to-skin for the first hour after cesarean and vaginal births in Egypt and the United States. Her newest DVD, the award winning *The Magical Hour: Holding Your Baby for the First Hour After Birth* is aimed at parents. Dr. Brimdyr is an advisor and faculty member for the BS in Maternal Child Health: Lactation Consulting at Union Institute & University, in Massachusetts.

<u>Liz Brooks, JD, IBCLC, FILCA</u> Liz is a lawyer/litigator and private practice IBCLC who brings to life the connection between lactation consultation and the law. Healthcare providers (HCPs) face ethical, moral and legal challenges every day in their clinical care. With plain language and humor, Liz explains how law and ethics affect IBCLCs and HCPs. She offers immediate, pragmatic tips so HCPs can practice ethically, legally and confidently. She is an Adjunct Professor in Drexel University's Human Lactation Consultation Program, in the greater Philadelphia area. She recently served as the President of ILCA & currently serves on the Boards of the US Breastfeeding Committee & Human Milk Banking Association of North America.

<u>Jennifer Thomas, MD, MPH, IBCLC, FAAP, FABM</u> Dr. Thomas is a pediatrician & breastfeeding medicine specialist at Aurora Health Care in Franklin, Wisconsin. She is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the Medical College of Wisconsin. She serves on the AAP Section on Breastfeeding Executive Board after spending several years as the Chief of the Chapter Breastfeeding Coordinators. She also serves on the Executive Board of the Wisconsin Chapter of the AAP. She is internationally recognized as a Fellow of the Academy of Breastfeeding Medicine (FABM) for her expertise on breastfeeding. Dr. Thomas' interests and research have focused on issues related to the use of social media to support breastfeeding mothers.
